



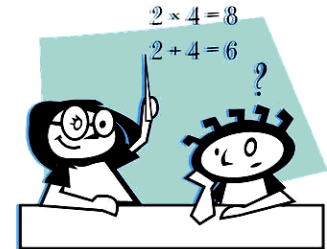

WHAT

Academically qualified high school students in grades 10-12 help younger students in grades 3-9 complete homework assignments. Open to Ridgewood Public Library cardholders. Students sign in with RPL card number upon arrival. Don't need assistance? Use our comfortable space to study on your own.



WHEN and WHERE

TUESDAYS and THURSDAYS @ 3:30-5:30pm. Oct. 20, 2015-May 26, 2016. No Homework Help on days when Ridgewood schools are closed or during RHS Midterm Exams week. Meet in the Ridgewood Library Auditorium (1st floor).

Do I need an APPOINTMENT?

No! Homework Help is a drop-in program. HOWEVER, if a student needs help in a particular subject, you may call the Children's Service Desk at 201-670-5600, ext. 110, to confirm that a volunteer with strengths in that area is scheduled the day you come. We will do our best to meet specific needs, where possible.

Anything ELSE I should know?

Basic school supplies (pencils, erasers, pens, markers, etc.), Wi-Fi and printers are available for use during Homework Help. **Please note that children under age 11 must have an adult caregiver IN the Library throughout the child's visit.**
