

# 2015 Ridge Halloween Parade

On Halloween the students of Ridge School have the opportunity to dress in their favorite costumes and parade around the school. Understanding that some families prefer that their children not participate in this activity, please know that dressing in costume is optional and at the discretion of individual families. For students who choose not to participate, an alternate activity will be available.

If your child is staying for lunch, they will be given time to change into costumes. Also, as you can imagine, the pick-up and drop-off area is very busy. Please follow the red zone rules.
